### Capture the County

AANC in conjunction with Old Firehouse Books presents its annual Capture the County Art Show, October 1 - 12, 2010. The show is open to all artists with a category for high school students. Juror to be announced.

#### Awards and Categories

Best of show and First place, second place, third place, and honorable mention in each category (Structures, Floral, People, Animals, Still life, Landscape, Abstract, High school art).

#### Fees

Entry fee is \$25.00 for AANC members, \$30.00 for non members, \$15 for students, for up to 2 pieces. All work must be for sale. A 30% commission will be retained on any work sold.

The show is open to all artists, including high school students. The theme is Larimer County. All entries must depict the county in some identifiable way, such as in the title. AANC manages and promotes the show so that all you have to do is pay the fee, deliver your artwork and pick it up again at the end of the show. Your artwork is exposed to customers of Old Firehouse Books in its prime location in Old Town and to people enjoying First Friday. Your artwork is shown in a secure environment that is open and staffed daily. The sales process is transparent to you because Old Firehouse Books will collect the money for sold items. Participation in the show and awards won will enhance your artist bio. See the prospectus for complete details. Failure to follow instructions may result in disqualification. The entry form and artwork title slips are contained in the prospectus. Download the prospectus, entry form and artwork title slips from AANC's website at [www.artistsassoc.org](http://www.artistsassoc.org). Artists may submit up to two (2) original art pieces. Largest piece must be no more than 22"x26" including frame. Total for both images must be no more than 1000 square inches. No gicleés or prints except for photography and photo art. All work must be prepared for hanging with wire (no sawtooth hangers or exposed glass edges). Unframed work must be wired for hanging, gallery wrapped, exposed edges painted, and no visible staples. For three dimensional (3d) pieces, artists must provide a display.

Seeing is a critical skill for the representational artist. Nature is full of so much information that it can often be overwhelming to paint. To paint the landscape, the artist must learn to see the important elements and nothing else! This intensive, 5-day workshop will focus on how to see. There is a direct correlation between proficiency with the fundamentals and the ability to see as an artist. Some of the fundamental skills discussed will include: seeing the abstract patterns and shapes, seeing the value and color relationships, seeing light, seeing edges, seeing relationships that occur in nature, seeing textures, seeing volume of mass, etc. Everyone sees in a unique way. What I see will differ from what you see, even when looking upon the same scene. We will discuss how to interpret your emotional response to the scene by understanding what and how you see. Once you understand what you see and why you respond to the scene, you can then paint a more meaningful expression of the landscape. We will paint on location daily. With the class size limited to 15 students, there will be plenty of one-on-one attention. The workshop will begin with a lecture and conclude with a group critique. The workshop is open to serious artists from beginner to professional.

No gicleés or prints except for photography and photo art. All work must be prepared for hanging with wire (no sawtooth hangers or exposed glass edges). Unframed work must be wired for hanging, gallery wrapped, exposed edges painted, and no visible staples.

For three dimensional (3d) pieces, artists must provide a display.

Entry fee is \$25.00 for AANC members, \$30.00 for non members, \$15 for high school students. All work must be for sale. A 30% commission will be retained on any work sold.

Old Firehouse Books and AANC will not be held responsible for any work which is lost, damaged or stolen.
